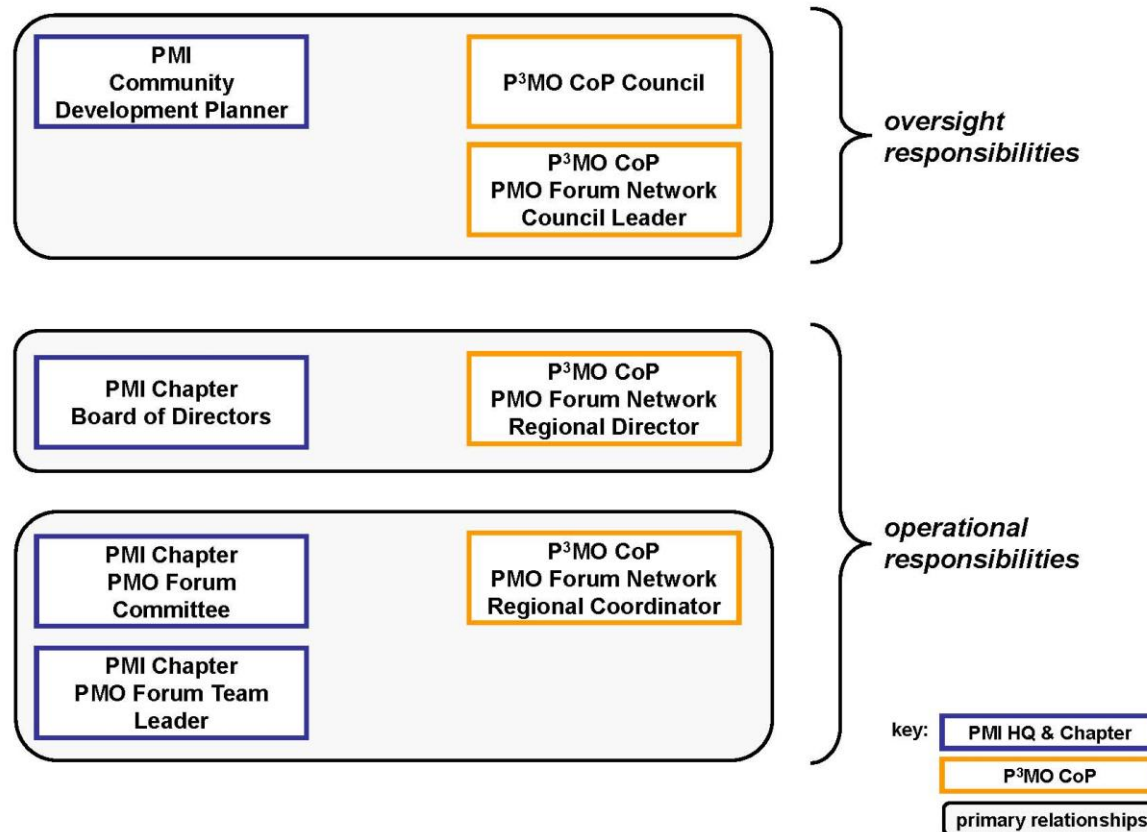
Goals/Objectives

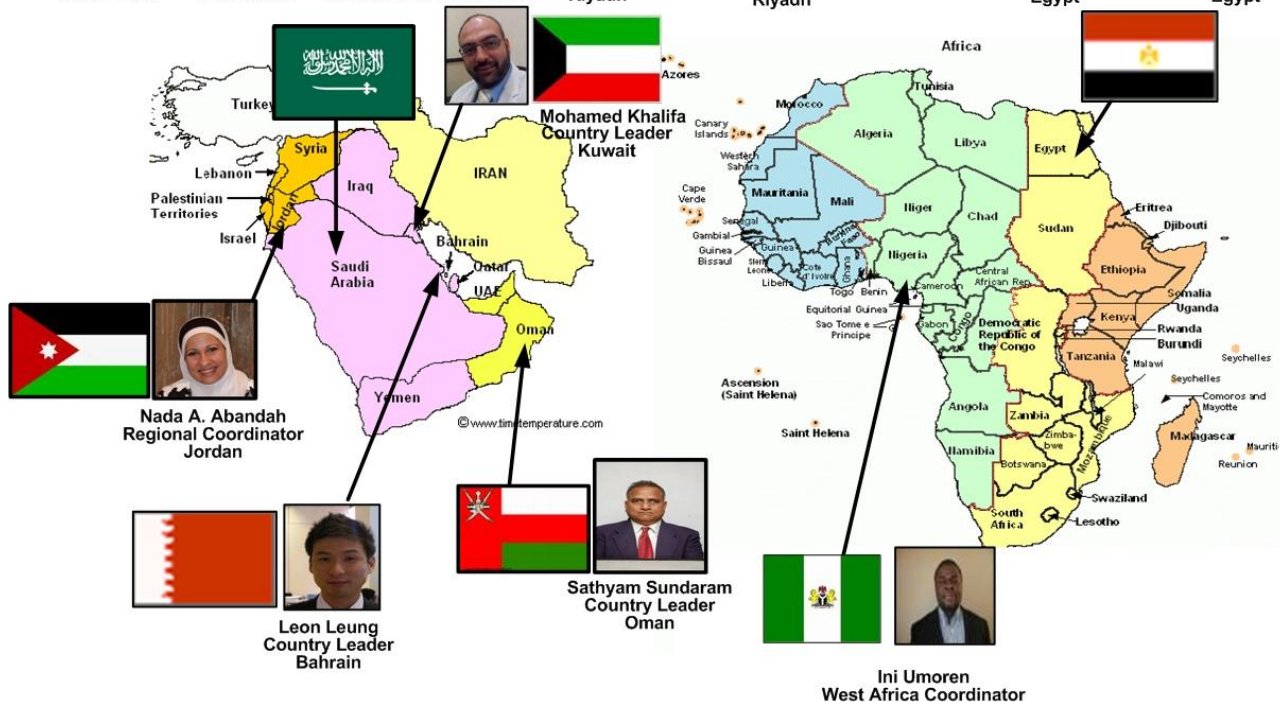

Current PMOSIG Activities

- The PMOSIG has **signed the PMI Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)** which spells out the agreements between PMI and the PMOSIG to complete its transition into the Community of Practice (CoP) in mid-December 2010.
- The PMOSIG will **operate as usual until that transition occurs**. The PMOSIG April Newsletter announced the signing of the MOU.

Current PMOSIG Activities - Continued

- The PMO Forum Network will remain an active PMOSIG program and transition into the future CoP at the end of 2010.
- The Vice-Chair, Public Relations is working directly with PMI HQ to identify the PMI and CoP roles and responsibilities for the PMO Forum Network Program.

Current Activities - Continued

- The PMOSIG Symposium and other members benefits will continue to be offered in future years once the CoP transition is completed.
- PMO Forum Network Regional Coordinators have been contacting PMI Chapters since the first of February 2010 to present the PMO Forum Network program defined in this presentation.
